

Canby, Oregon, August 3rd 1918.

Council met in Special session at 7.30 P.M. and was called to order by W.H. Bair, Mayor, Present Mayor W.H. Bair, Recorder C.N. Wait, Marshall C.E. Bowman, and Councilmen H.A. Deadman, John Eid, H.B. Evans, C.F. White and C.C. Combs. There being a quorum present the Council then resolved itself into a Committee of the whole, with W.H. Bair as Chairman, to consider the drafting and reporting of amendments to the charter of Canby, for submission to the voters of said city for their adoption or rejection at an election to be held thereafter. After debate of the proposed amendment the chairman of said committee arose and made the following report:

To the Honorable Mayor and Council of Canby:
Gentlemen:

We, your Committee of the whole to whom was referred the matter of drafting and reporting amendments to the charter of Canby for submission to the voters of said City at a special election to be held hereafter, herewith submit the following proposed amendments to the charter and recommend your Honorable Body that the same be submitted to the voters of Canby, for their adoption or rejection.
