

Council met in special session, and was called to order by W.H. Bair Mayor at 7.30, P.M. There were present Mayor W.H. Bair, Recorder C.N. Wait, Marshall C.E. Bowman, and Councilmen C.C. Combs, H.A. Nedman, John Eld, H.B. Evans, Ora Slyter and L.H. Wang. The Mayor stated the nature of the special meeting to be, the attending to the necessary matters in relation to the adoption of certain matters necessary to the Charter of Canby in relation to elections. Whereupon the Recorder read the following resolution, a motion to adopt was made by John Eld and seconded by H.B. Evans.

RESOLUTION.

Be it resolved that a Bill for an act entitled an act to amend Chapters II and III of the Charter of Canby, in Clackamas County, Oregon, entitled "A Bill for an act entitled an act to incorporate Canby, in Clackamas County State of Oregon; fixing the boundaries thereof; providing for the election and appointment of its officers, defining their qualifications, their duties, their powers and fixing their terms of office; providing for the organization of the City Council, the manner of the passage of ordinances, the establishment of the grade of any street or alley, and for the improvement thereof, the building and repair of sidewalks, the laying out and establishing of sewer districts and the construction of sewers and drains therein, the levying and collecting of assessments, and the re-assessments for the cost of improvements of streets and allies and the constructing of sewers and drains; providing for a Pocket of City Liens, for the sale and redemption of property on account of delinquent assessments, for the condemnation of property for public use, for the issuance of bonds, for the owning, building and maintaining of water works for the said City; for the raising and expenditure of public money; for the liability of Canby; validating the past acts of Canby; fixing the terms of office of the present officials and repealing all acts in conflict herewith"

filed in the office of the Recorder of Canby on the 3rd day of August 1918. be and the same hereis and hereby adopted to be submitted to the vote of the legal voters of Canby, in Clackamas County, State of Oregon at a special election to be held on Wednesday, October 30th 1918, for the adoption or rejection.

Whereas, it is necessary that Canby immediately amend the Charter to make the provisions thereof conform to the Constitution of the State of Oregon, so that proper officers may be elected to represent and govern the City.

Now therefore to preserve the peace, health and safety of Canby and of the citizens of Canby an emergency is hereby declared and this resolution shall become immediately operative upon its passage by the Council.

The vote for the adoption of said resolution was as follows:

Ayes: Combs, Dedman, Eld, Evans, Slyter and Kang.

Noes:

The Mayor then declared the resolution adopted, approved same and declared said resolution in full force and effect.

The Recorder then read the following Ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 41

An Ordinance providing for a special election for the purpose of submitting to a vote of the legal voters of Canby, in Clackamas County, Oregon, for their adoption or rejection, amendments of the Charter of Canby and which said ~~Charter~~ proposed amendments are entitled as follows: A Bill for an act entitled an act to amend Chapters II and III of the Charter of Canby, Oregon, in Clackamas County, entitled a Bill for an act to incorporate Canby in Clackamas County, State of Oregon: fixing the boundaries thereof; providing for the election and appointment of its officers, defining their qualifications, their duties, their powers, and fixing their terms of office; providing for the organization of the City Council, the manner of the passage of ordinances, the establishment or alteration of the grade of any street or alley and for the improvement thereof, the building and repairing of sidewalks, the laying out and establishing of sewer districts, and the construction of sewers and drains therein, the levying of and collection of assessments and the pre-assessment for the cost of improvements of streets and alleys and the construction of sewers and drains; providing for a docket of City liens, for the sale and redemption of property on account of delinquent assessments, for the condemnation of property for public use, for the issuance of bonds, for the owning, building and maintaining of water works for said City for the

raising and expenditure of public money; for the liability of Canby; validating the past acts of Canby; fixing the terms of office of its present officials, and repealing all the acts and parts of acts in conflict herewith.

And to provide for the printing of said Bill and its distribution among the voters, And also providing for the posting of notices of the said special election; providing for the appointment of judges and clerks of said election, fixing their compensation; establishing the election ward or precinct for said election and designating the polling places for the same and declaring an emergency by which this ordinance shall become immediately operative.

CANBY DOES OBTAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I: That there shall be held in Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, on Wednesday October 30th 1918, a special election for the purpose of submitting to a vote of the legal voters of Canby, for their adoption or rejection amendments to the Charter of Canby which said amendments are entitled as follows: A Bill for an act to amend Chapters II and III of the Charter of Canby in Clackamas County, Oregon, entitled a Bill for an act to incorporate Canby in Clackamas County, State of Oregon; fixing the boundaries thereof; providing for the election and appointment of its officers and defining their qualifications, their duties, their powers; and fixing their terms of office; providing for the organization of the City Council, the manner of passage of ordinances; the establishment or alteration of the grade of any street or alley, and for the improvement thereof; the building and repair of sidewalks, the laying out and establishment of sewers districts and the construction of sewers and drains therein, the levying and collecting of assessments and re-assessments for the cost of improvements of streets and alleys and the construction of sewers and drains; providing for a docket of City liens, for the sale and redemption of property on account of delinquent assessments; for public use, for the issuance of bonds, for the owning, building and maintaining of water works for the said City; for the raising and expenditure of public money; for the liability of Canby; validating the past acts of Canby;

fixing the terms of office of the present officials and repealing all acts and parts of acts in conflict herewith.

Section 2. The Recorder of Canby is hereby authorized and directed to post in six conspicuous and public places within the corporate limits of Canby, in Clackamas County, Oregon, for at least ten days prior to Wednesday October 30th, 1918, which ~~said notice of election~~ shall notices of the special City election to be held in Canby on said date, to wit: Wednesday October 30th 1918, which said notices of election shall state the date upon which the said election shall be held and shall designate the purpose of said election, the polling place thereof, and the hours that said polls shall be kept open, and shall name the judges and clerks of said election and give the ballot title of the proposed acts to be submitted to a vote of the legal voters of Canby, for their adoption or rejection at said special City election.

Section 3. The Council of Canby shall, by motion, hereafter appoint judges and clerks of said special election; said judges and clerks shall receive as full compensation for their services as such the sum of three dollars per day each.

Section 4. The election ward or precinct for such special City election shall be and constitute all the territory included within the corporate limits of Canby.

Section 5. There shall be one polling place for said special City election, to wit: in the Council chamber of the City Hall.

Section 6. The Recorder is hereby authorized to have a sufficient number of copies of said acts printed and distributed among the voters of Canby, letting the bid for printing to the lowest responsible bidder.

Section 7. Whereas it is necessary that the Charter be immediately changed and amended to make it conform to the Constitution of the State of Oregon, so that the proper officers may be

electd to represent and govern the city, an emergency is hereby declar
ed and in order to preserve the peace, health and safety of Canby and of
the citizens of Canby, this ordinance shall become immediately operative
upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Read for the first time at a special meeting of the Council of Canby
held on the 10th day of August 1918, and because the charges for
publication thereof, are in the judgment of the Council, excessive, publica
tion was dispensed with and the Recorder was ordered to post the same
in three public and conspicuous places in said City for a period of two
full weeks, and to come up for final passage at a special meeting of the
Council to be held on the 26th day of August 1918 at 7.30. o'clock P.M.

On motion of John Eid seconded by C.C. Combs, this was considered the first
reading and ordered posted for the reason that the charges for the publi
cation thereof were, in the judgment of the Council, excessive, and said
publication was hereby dispensed with, said ordinance was ordered posted
in three public and conspicuous places in said City for a period of two
full calender weeks, and to come up for final passage at a special
meeting of the Council to be held on the 26th day of August A.D. 1918, at
eight o'clock P.M.

Whereupon the Recorder then read the following resolution and moved
for its adoption, seconded by C.C. Combs.

RESOLUTION.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of Canby, that whereas, heretofore the
Council of Canby, has adopted and enacted proposed amendments to the
Charter of Canby, to be voted upon at an election to be held on Wednesday
October 30th 1918, at ~~a special meeting of the Council~~ ^{XXXXXX} and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that said proposed amendments be printed and
distributed to the voters of Canby before said election.

NOW THEREFORE, the Recorder of Canby is hereby instructed to

call for bids for the printing of the said measures, as required by law, said bids to be submitted on or before Sept 28th 1918, and to be opened on Sept 30th 1918, at a special meeting of the Council. Further, that the Recorder prepare such notices and do such other things as may be necessary to carry out the intention of this act.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that Canby immediately have said Charter amended to preserve the peace, health and safety of said City, and whereas, to enact said amendments it is necessary that the same be printed immediately, therefore, in order to preserve the peace, health and safety of Canby this resolution shall become immediately operative upon its passage by the Council, so that said bids may be called for.

On roll call for the adoption of said resolution, the vote was as follows:
