SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

Canby, Oregon, November 19th 1917.

A special meeting of the City Council was called to order by the Mayor, W. H. Bair, at 8 o'clock P. M.

Upon roll call the following were present:

Mayor, W. H. Bair, Recorder J. Lee Eckerson, Mershall F. G. Bowman Councilmen, L. H. Wang, C. G. Combs, John Eid, H. B. Evans, H. A. Dedman and G. W. White.

The Recorder reported that John Fid had qualified as Councilman on November 6th 1917.

The Recorder read an ordinance entitled "An ordinance for the purpose of levying a tax of Two thousand seven hundred forty two Dollars on all the taxable property, both real and personal within the City of Canby, and declaring an emergency."

Read for the first time November 5th 1917, and ordered published according to law, and to come up for final passage at a special meeting to be held on November 19th 1917.

Attached to the ordinance was the following affidavit:

That the amount charged for said notice \$3.45.
