whereupon a motion was made and seconded that said bills be ordered paid. Carried.

On roll call; Ayes: Graham, Dedman Combs, Bates and Wang.

Whereupon the Recorder read the following ordinance,

Ordinance No. 132.

193
An Ordinance directing and instructing the Mayor and Recorder of Canby to enter into a lease agreement with the Southern Pacific Company for the purpose of securing the right to lay water mains under the track and on the right of way of the said Company, and providing for the payment of One Dollar per year for said right, and declaring an emergency.

Canby does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and Recorder of Canby are hereby directed and instructed to ~~execute~~ ^{for Canby} ~~into~~ a written lease with the Southern Pacific Company, a copy of which lease was filed in the Recorder office September 1, 1916, in which lease the City of Canby will secure the right to lay and maintain water pipes and mains under the tracks and on the right of way of the said Southern Pacific Company.

Section 2. That Canby shall pay the Southern Pacific Company, as therein set out the sum of One Dollar per year for said privilege.

Section 3. Whereas Canby is constructing a municipal water system, in order to furnish the citizens thereof with an adequate supply of pure water for house hold use and for fire protection, now therefore, an emergency is hereby declared, and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the mayor, in order to protect the health and safety of Canby.

Read for the first time and ordered posted for the reason the charges of publication were in the opinion of the Council excessive, and to come up for final reading on the 16th day of October, 1916, at 8 o'clock at a special meeting of the Council.

Motion made and second that a warrant be drawn in favor of S. A. Cobb for \$400.00 partly compensation for services on water works, Carried. Ayes; Graham, Dedman, Combs, Bates and Wang: Noes, none.

Whereupon Council adjourned to meet September 25, 1916
