In ~~The~~ matter of the extensions of the water mains, it was laid on the table until the system could be **completely finished.**

In ~~The~~ matter of the well for the Canby Water Works, it was taken up and the committee reported that the contract had been let to R. C. Schaubel for \$2.75 per foot, for the first One Hundred feet, and the committee was instructed to use its own judgment in regard to changing the contract, so as to furnish the contractor with a steel shoe with the well casings and whether or not the well should be pumped or bailed..

The purchase of a fire hose and fire carts for Canby, was referred to the committee on fire and water, with orders to report at a special meeting to be held on December 18, 1916, for that purpose.

The recorder was instructed to draw an ordinance in regard to sale of meat, fish and vegetables on the Streets of Canby. The recorder was instructed to rewrite the fire insurance on City Hall for the coming year, in a standard company.

The report of the committee on the Streets and Public property was received in regard to street work done during the month of November: ~~Whereupon~~ the recorder, in the presence of the Council preceeded to canvass the vote of the annual city election, held on the 4th day of December, 1916, and **announced** that the following was the result thereof:

That J. Lee Eckerson be, and he is hereby declared to have been elected as Treasurer of Canby for the term of one year, commencing January 1, 1917.

That Grant White, H. A. Dedman, H. B. Evans, L. H. Wang, be and are hereby declared to have been elected as Councilmen for the respective terms, commencing January 1, 1917.


