

June 21, 1916.

Special meeting of the Council of Canby called to order by the Mayor, on Wednesday, June 21, 1916, at eight o'clock P. M.

On roll call the following were present; Mayor, W. H. Bair; Recorder, P. L. Hammond; Chief of Police, E. Bowsby; Councilmen Wang, Slyter, White, Combs, Stacy and Graham.

The recorder read an ordinance entitled: "An ordinance providing for the plans and specifications for the water works system of Canby; providing the manner of advertising for and letting the bids for the same; authorizing the issuance of bonds for the purpose of building and maintaining said water works; providing the manner of selling and disposing of said bonds; repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith and setting forth an emergency so as to make the same immediately operative."

"Read for the first time and ordered posted at a regular meeting of the Council of Canby held on the 5th day of June, A. D. 1916, and to come up for final passage at a special meeting of said council to be held in said City on the 21st day of June, A. D. 1916 at 8 o'clock P. M."

Said ordinance has attached thereto the following affidavit:

I, J. Lee Eckerson, being first duly sworn depose and say; that I am the acting Recorder of the City of Canby. That I did on Monday, June 1, 1916,

post true and correct copies of the attached ordinance in three public and conspicuous places within the City of Canby, to-wit; One in the window of the Mollala Electric Company's building on First Street; one in the window of C. G. Comb's tailor shop, on C Street and one on the front of the fire house in the City Hall. That all of said copies so posted were in plain view of passers-by, and remained continuously posted for a period of two full calendar weeks thereafter,

Motion made that said ordinance be placed on its final passage. Carried. On roll call the vote was as follows:

AYES: Wang, Slyter, White, Combs, Stacy and Graham.

NOES: None.

Whereupon the Mayor declared said ordinance passed and immediately approved and signed a copy thereof.

The following resolution was then introduced by L. H. Wang:

"Be it resolved by the council of Canby that the plans and specifications for constructing a water system for Canby, prepared by S. A. Gobb, engineer for the City filed in the office of the Recorder on June 21, 1916, be and the same are hereby adopted by the Council of Canby as the plans and specifications for said water system,

"The Mayor and Recorder of Canby are hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said water works, for the furnishing of material and performing of all labor, in two publications of general circulation, most likely in their discretion to bring the same to the attention of those most likely to bid upon the same. Provided, one shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the County of Clackamas, Oregon. All of said advertisements shall direct that bids on said proposals shall be mailed or delivered to the Recorder of Canby, and must reach him not later than the 17th day of July, A. D. 1916.

"Whereas, it is necessary to build, erect and maintain a water works system within Canby to preserve the peace, health and safety of Canby, and the citizens of Canby, this resolution shall become operative upon its adoption by the Council."

Motion made that said resolution be adopted.

Carried. On roll call the vote was as follows:

AYES: Wang, Slyter, White, Combs, Stacy and Graham,


NOES: None.
