

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL.

May 13, 1915.

Special meeting of the City Council was called to order by the Mayor at 1.00 o'clock P. M. on May 13th, 1915.

On roll call the following were present; The Mayor, Recorder, Councilmen Sutherland, Stacy, Dedman, Graham, White and Gilmore.

The Council was informed that this meeting was called to discuss the matter of the case of Canby vs. Clackamas County. The following resolution was introduced:

BE IT RESOLVED, that Canby instruct its present City Attorney to carry the case of Canby vs. Clackamas County to a favorable determination, or until such time as he believed it would be impossible to further proceed with hope of success, and if necessary to appeal the same to the Supreme Court."

The Recorder was instructed to note the arrival of councilman George Meeks at this time.

After discussion, roll was called on the passage of the foregoing resolution, and was as follows:

YES: Sutherland, Graham and White,

NO : Gilmore, Stacy and Dedman.

Councilman Meeks declining to vote either yes or no, declaring that he was as yet unable to make up his mind, whereupon there being a tie the Mayor voted Yes.

Motion was then made by councilman Gilmore re-considering the resolution, which was seconded. Upon roll call the resolution was adopted unanimously.

On motion meeting adjourned.
