

Regular meeting of the City Council.

Ajourned meeting of October 5, 1914. Meeting called to order October 6, 1914, by J. Lee Eckerson, in the absence of the Mayor, on roll call the following were present, President of the Council, J. Lee Eckerson, recorder, Hammond; Councilman, Gillmore Wang, Sutherland, White and Hewett.

Report of the City Treasurer read, for the third quarter, showing balance at the end of the second quarter \$2576.04, to receipts as shown by report \$101.71, total receipts and balance \$2777.75, less 40 warrants drawn during third quarter amounting to \$526.13, leaving a balance in the treasury of the sum of \$2251.62, submitted by Leroy D. Walker, Treasurer.

Motion made that report be accepted, seconded and carried.

That the following resolution was passed by the City Council and ordered written in the minutes:

It is hereby ordered by the City Council of the City of Canby, County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, that whereas the following side walks are in a dangerous condition, they are hereby ordered to be repaired, on D street from 1st Street to 2nd Street, on the west side of block 4, of the Town of Canby; on the east side of C Street on the Southern Pacific Company's right of way being that part of the side walk south of the main track of the Southern Pacific Company; on the west side of Lot 1, of Block 1, of Heman A. Lee Addition to the City of Canby. That the side walk on D Street shall be repaired so that the same is five feet wide, across the Southern Pacific Company's right of way seven feet, at Lot 1, block 4, of Heman A. Lee's Addition 4 feet. That copies of this order be served as provided for in the City charter on the owners of the said property, described herein.
