

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL.

Meeting called to order by the mayor, H. W. Bair, on roll call the following were present, Recorder, Hammond, Chief of Police, Leiser, Councilmen, Eckerson, Gillmore, Sutherland, Meek and Stacy.

Motion declared carried, and recorder ordered to draw warrants for said bills.

Concrete cross walks were ordered placed in when the weather permitted between all cement sidewalks. The proposition

Committee reports on the result of their interview with Mr. Telford, relative to opening of C Street, stating that they had received a deed from Mr. Telford to a strip of land for said street, and had delivered to Mr. Telford a deed given them by Dr. Pedman, that the sum of \$300.00 was owing to Dr. Pedman, if this agreement was carried out.

Motion made and second that the Recorder draw an ordinance, appropriating the sum of \$300.00, to be paid to Dr. Pedman for a strip of land on the east side of C. Street.

Carried.

Motion made that Mr. Telford be notified that the Council except his deed and will commence grading the street as soon as the weather permits, carried.

Recorder instructed to draft a building ordinance, to be referred to Stacy, Eckerson and Wang, who were to report on the same at the next meeting.
