

Minutes of Regular Session of the City Council.
Oct. 6, 1913.

City Council met in The City Hall Oct 6, 1913 at 8:00 P.M. and was called to order by Mayor H. A. Dedman.

The following members of the Council were present:- Mayor H. A. Dedman; Recorder C. F. Roney; Chief of Police Joe Liss; Councilmen:- J. L. Eckerson, H. J. Hewett, John Graham, W. H. Bair and L. H. Wang.

Minutes of Sept. 3rd read and approved.

Remonstrance, filed with the Recorder by Andrew Kocher, asking that the property owners around Block No. 12 be allowed to substitute a gravel walk, was read and after some discussion into which Andrew Kocher & F. M. Roth entered, the Council agreed that on A St. on the South Side of the Block that a gravel walk be allowed, but that a board walk be required on the West end of said Block, #12, whereupon motion was made & carried that the property owners of Block #12 be allowed to build gravel walks on Second and A Streets only. Mr. Kocher then withdrew the remonstrance.

Mr. Adam Knight spoke at length about the walks ordered built and urged the City to put in the crossings as rapidly as the walks were completed so that the walks might be a benefit to the public. The suggestions were well taken and heartily endorsed & the Street Commissioner was ordered to put in the crossings as soon as possible.
