

Minutes of City Council 243
Special Session Nov. 10, 1913

At the call of Acting Mayor H.C. Gillmore, the City Council met in extra session at 8:00 P.M. Nov. 10, 1913 at the City Hall, & was called to order.

Upon roll call the following responded Pres. of Council H. C. Gillmore & Recorder C. F. Ronning, Chief of Police, for Lieux; Councilmen: F. L. Eckerson, J. E. Southstrand, L. H. Wang, Grant White and W. A. Bair.

The object of the meeting was then stated by Chairman Gillmore, which was as follows: - That it was found upon investigation that in order to get our tax assessment on the tax roll, the ordinance providing for same need an emergency clause & must be passed before Dec. 1, 1913. Thereupon the revised ordinance providing for a $7\frac{1}{2}$ mill tax levy was read by the recorder and upon motion, the roll being called, seven members ^{present}, voted yes & ordinance was ordered posted.

Then the Council adjourned to meet again Nov. 25, 1913 at 7:30 P.M. when this ordinance #113 would come up for final passage.
