A special session of the City Council was called by the Mayor to meet Messers Hendrick & Standard in reference to a proposed water system which they desired to install in the City of Canby.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor H. A. Dedman at 7:30 P.M. in the City Hall~~###~~. The following responded to their names as the roll was called:- Mayor H. A. Dedman; Recorder, C. F. Romig; Chief of Police, E. C. Shull; Councilmen, H. C. Gillmore, J. L. Eckerson, L. H. Wang, Grant White, W. H. Bair and H. J. Hewett.

Messers Hendrick and Standard were allowed to present their plans for a water system to be installed in Canby, or rather for the enlargement of the system already existing. After listening to the report ~~#####~~ Councilmen, J. L. Southerland, J. L. Eckerson and W. H. Bair were appointed a committee to investigate the water systems of neighboring towns, price of installing same and expense of their operation.

A partial report was received from the committee who were to go over the road leading through the gravel pit, and they advised that the work be taken up at the earliest possible date.
