

Minutes of Mar. 3, 1913.

The City Council met in regular session Mar. 3, 1913, and was called to order by Mayor H. A. Dedman.

Upon roll call the following responded: Mayor H. A. Dedman; Recorder, C. F. Rowing; Chief of Police, E. C. Skull; Councilmen: N. C. Kilmore, J. L. Eckerson, John Graham, J. E. Southwold, L. H. Wang, Grant White and W. H. Bair; Councilman H. J. Hewitt being the only member absent.

motion was made by Councilman J. E. Eckman seconded by Councilman Bill Wore that bills be allowed & warrants be ordered drawn on the Treasurer for same. The roll was called & motion was unananimously carried all voting 'yes' as their names were called.

Whereupon report of Special Committee to investigate water systems of surrounding towns and the expense of construction & maintenance, consisting of J. Lee Eckman, W. H. Bair, Arthur J. E. Southland and made a report of that of Woodburn.

Motion made by Councilman L. H. Wang, seconded by Councilman Bill Wore that - The Committee be continued and report at the next session of the Council.

Motion made by Councilman J. E. Southland, seconded by Councilman Eckman Wang that \$5000 be appropriated to the work on the road through the gravel pit. The roll was called and resulted in an unanimous vote in favor of the appropriation. Work was ordered started at once.

Recorder was instructed to notify P. W. Zimmerman that he could obtain gravel from the excavation of new road which he might use on the road to Barlow.

Recorder reported that he had attended to the duties assigned him at last session of Council. Council adjourned.
