

Apr. 10, 1913

Council met in adjourned session Apr. 10, 1913 at the City Hall at 8:00 P.M. and was called to order by H. C. Gillmore, Pres. of the Council.

The subject of water works was brought up and discussed, but no definite conclusions were reached: also the subject of the toilets of the town was taken up & discussed and it was advised that the Health and Police Committee investigate and render a report at the next regular meeting of the Council.

The condition of the floor in the City Hall was also discussed and it was declared unsafe, therefore it was ordered rebuilt.

Councilman, W. H. Bair suggested that the sidewalks should be put in on both sides of A, B, C, D, & E. Streets and extend from 1st & including Third Streets.

Motion made & carried unanimously (the roll being called) that - (\$250.00) Two Hundred Fifty Dollars more be appropriated for work on the road through the Gravel Pit.

Motion made & carried that the Recorder be instructed to post notices requesting citizens to remove moss from the roofs and also have this notice published in the Canby Irrigator.
