

Minutes of June 2, 1913.
Regular Session of the City Council.

The City Council met in regular session June 2nd, 1913 at the City Hall at 8:00 P.M. Council was called to order by Mayor H. A. Dedman.

Upon roll call the following responded: - Mayor H. A. Dedman; Recorder C. F. Roung; Chief of Police Joe Lissner; Councilmen: H. C. Gillman, J. L. Erickson, John Graham, H. J. Hewitt, J. E. Southland, W. H. Bair, L. H. Wang and Grant White.

Recorder was also ordered to order a large sized tank oil car of oil at once for use in oiling streets. Council adjourned.
