The City Council of the City of Canby met in regular session in the City Hall, Monday evening, July 7, 1913 at 8:00 P.M.

Council was called to order by Mayor H. A. Dedman.

The following responded to the roll call; - Mayor H. A. Dedman; Recorder C. F. Romig; Chief of Police, Joe Lieser; Councilmen; H. C. Gillmore, J. L. Eckerson, John Graham, J. E. Southland, H. J. Hewitt, W. H. Bair, Grant White, and L. H. Wang.

Minutes of the meeting of June 2, were read, approved and ordered placed on file.

Under the head of Communications, the Elite picture show people made a request to rent City Hall permanently by the year.

The City was also asked to vacate a portion of the road along R. R. track adjoining Albert Lee's Addition to Canby.

The former of these requests was referred to the Mayor & Recorder for adjustment, while the latter was referred to the Committee on Streets and Public Property.
