

Regular Session of City Council Sept. 3, 1912

Council convened at the City Hall, Sept. 3, 1912 and was called to order by Mayor H.A. Dedman

Motion was made by Councilman H.C. Gillmore, seconded by Joe Lieser that the claims be allowed and warrants ordered drawn for the same, whereupon the roll was called and all present voted in favor of the motion.

Motion made and carried that J. C. Kampisch be given 24 hours to dispose of water and refuse from crabs otherwise than on the streets, Motion carried.

Motion made and carried that street-commissioner be given charge of earth and gravel ^{from arguments to be paid} to distribute same on the streets as he might see proper, Motion carried.
