Newton and Joe Lieser.

Letter from Atty Sheffield relative
to the action already taken in the
matter of opening "C" Street; said
letter specifying that suit was stayed
by Atty of Nebraska until we might
reconsider the appraisers report of
damages and benefits allowed Max
Jefford for land ^{to be} appropriated.

Motion made by Councilman
J. L. Eckerson, seconded by Council-
man J. R. Newton that the ordi-
nance be drafted making the action
taken relative to the opening of "C"
Street.

Motion made by J. L. Eckerson
that an eight (8) foot sidewalk
be ordered built between 2nd and
4th Streets on the East Side of "C"
St. Motion was seconded by Coun-
cilman H. C. Giffmon and upon
putting the question was unan-
imously carried.

Street Commissioner Wilson
was instructed to order
said sidewalk built.
