

Minutes of Adjourned Meeting of
The Council Dec. 9, 1912.

The Adjourned meeting of the City Council was called to order at 8:00 o'clock P.M. Dec 9, 1912 at The City Hall by Mayor H. A. Dedman

Upon roll call the following were found present, to-wit:-

Mayor H. A. Dedman, Recorder C. F. Roring, Chief of Police, E. C. Shull, Councilmen, H. C. Billman, for Liseser, J. L. Eckerson, John Graham, H. J. Hewitt and J. R. Newton

Mr. J. B. Eddy, Tax & Right of Way Agent of S. P. R. R., was present as had been arranged. He explained the methods that would be agreeable to the R. R. Co. by which we might proceed to open a public highway continuing Main Street through the Gravel Pit to the bridge across the Molalla River leading to Barlow, which road would be on the Oregon & California Rail Road Company's Right of Way.

Motion made and carried that we appropriate the land designated by Mr. Eddy and that an ordinance be drawn doing this and also that it include the vacation of the present wagon road to this bridge.

A crossing over the R. R. track about 100 yds. South of the existing crossing into the Fair Grounds was requested of Mr. Eddy, who agreed to take this matter up at once at the first meeting of the R. R. officials.

Recorder C. F. Roring reported that he had gotten the necessary information as to the nature of petition, etc., for requesting of the County Court that

whereupon motion was made
that the Recorder circulate this
petition. Motion carried.
