

Called Session of City Council

Feb. 26, 1912.

At the call of Mayor H. A. Dedman, Council met at 8:00 P. M. Feb. 26th in the office of the Molalla Power Co.

Upon Roll call the following were found present, to-wit:- Mayor H. A. Dedman, Recorder, C. F. Rorvig; Chief of Police 'E. C. Shull', and Councilmen; J. L. Eckerson, H. C. Gillmore, J. A. Graham and J. R. Newton.

Ordinance relative to dog tax amending Ordinance # 84 was read and upon motion was placed on final passage, the result of which was that it carried unanimously, all five of the Councilmen present voting.

Upon motion the Chief of Police was ordered to solicit and collect dog taxes and a compensation of 25% was allowed him for collecting same.

Moved and carried that a Committee of three be appointed to make a draft of that part of the City adjoining the R. R. and negotiate with the officers of the R. R. Co. to secure extension of switches and other improvements which might seem necessary; whereupon Councilmen, J. R. Newton, J. L. Eckerson and H. C. Gillmore were appointed to constitute said Committee.

Motion made instructing the Recorder to place notice in the newspaper forbidding persons from placing rocks, gravel and dirt or otherwise obstructing the streets without a permit from the Street Commissioner.
