

Regular Session of City Council.

Apr. 1, 1912.

Council called to order at 8:30 P.M.
by Henry A. Dedman, Mayor.Upon roll call the following were
found present to-wit:Mayor, H. A. Dedman, Recorder C. F. Romig,
- Chief of Police E. C. Shull, Councilmen:
H. C. Billmore, John Graham, J. E. South-
land, J. R. Newton and Geo. WeeksMinutes of the regular session of Mar. 4,
1912 and also the minutes of the
special called meeting of Mar. 12, 1912,
were read, approved and placed on
record.Under communications, a letter from
Mr. Fields, a mgs. of S. P. R. R. relative
to the opening of a road through
the gravel pit was read.Thereupon bills against the city were
presented and upon motion were allow-
ed (all present voting yes as their names
were called), the following being the

The Committee on Streets and Public
properly presented the matter of putting

in a public watering trough and repairing the pump & putting in a public drinking fountain. M. J. Lee who was present offered to furnish the water free of cost for such a fountain if the City would put it in, and after receiving the opinions of those present it being the opinion of those expressing their views that it would be better to establish a sanitary drinking fountain. This was then referred to Com. on Streets and Public Property by Mayor H. A. Dedman. Councilman Muecke presented the need of repairs on Store Building, which was also referred to Com. on Streets & Public Property.

Moved that ordinances ~~# 104 and~~ ^{# 106} relative to the opening of ~~"C" Street and~~ ^{Fanton Street} respectively ~~was~~ placed on final passage and ~~was~~ passed unanimously (Vote being determined by roll call and Councilmen: Billmon, Graham, Southerland, Newton and Muecke voting in favour of ordinances)

Councilmen J. E. Southerland, Geo. Muecke and H. C. Billmon were appointed to look over the ground relative to opening a road into the bottom land along the Molalla River South West of town.

Recorder was instructed to look after getting our pro. rata of the general road fund from the County.
