

Special Called Meeting of June 10th 1912.

The City Council met at the call of Mayor H. A. Dedman on the 10th day of June, 1912 and was called to order by Mayor H. A. Dedman at 8:00 P. M.

Upon roll call the following were present, to-wit:- Mayor H. A. Dedman; Recorder, C. F. Roming; Chief of Police, E. C. Shull and Councilmen, W. C. Gillmore, Joe Lieser, J. L. Eckerson, John Graham, J. E. Southland, J. R. Newton, Geo. Meek & H. J. Herrett.

The cause of the special call was to consider a petition which requested that Mr. J. Lee be granted a 75-year franchise for a R. R. to come into Canby and to consider the franchise. This petition signed by a large number of Citizens of Canby was read, whereupon Mr. J. Lee arose and stated that he had decided that the franchise be granted direct to the Portland, Eugene & Eastern R. R. Co. instead of himself as an individual. This was followed by the reading of the franchise drafted in the form of an ordinance and upon motion, the roll having been called, it was unanimously voted to pass the franchise on its first reading. Then motion was made and carried that the ordinance be published in the Canby Irrigator, moved and carried that the emergency clause be added to this ordinance.

The matter of installing public closets on City lot was introduced. Whereupon the Mayor referred this matter to Committee on Streets & Public Property giving them full authority to act.

Progress was reported by Committee on installing a Public watering trough. Council adjourned.
