

Regular session of the City Council July 1, 1912.
The City Council met at the City Hall at 8:00 P.M. and was called to order by Mayor H. A. Dedman.

Upon roll call the following were found present, to-wit:— Mayor H. A. Dedman; Recorder, C. F. Romig; Chief of Police, E. C. Shull; Councilmen: H. C. Gillmore, Jos. Lieser, J. T. Eckerson, John Graham, J. R. Newton, W. S. Weeks and H. J. Hewett.

Minutes of the regular Council of June 3, 1912 and also of special meeting of June 10, 1912 were read, approved and placed on file.

Whereupon the following claims were presented and upon motion were ordered paid, every councilman present, voting, yes, as his name was called:—

Balance of amount pledged toward securing drinking fountain was placed in the hands of Recorder, C. F. Romig to collect.

The question of putting tile in the ditch to drain that part of town near the Cannery was discussed and upon motion was made and seconded

That suitable tiling be put in this ditch to extend a hundred feet or more below the fence, whereupon motion was made that this motion be placed upon the table, motion carried.

Several lights were reported out.

Ord. #107 ~~was~~ relative to the widening of Fanton Street and the extension of "C" Street was read and on motion was placed on final passage. Before the roll was called and the vote taken, Mr. Wm. Cantwell, who was present, presented a claim for \$100.00 damages instead of \$45.00 as was allowed. This request was not allowed and upon roll call Ordinance #107 was unanimously passed.

Ordinance #108 was then read for the second time and upon motion was placed on its final passage, (this ordinance relative to the franchise to the Portland, Eugene and Eastern Railway Co's Franchise) and was unanimously passed. Motion made & carried that Council adjourn.
