

Regular Session of Jan 2nd 1911

Council called to order at 8 PM by Mayor

In regard to premium of Horticultural Ins
Co, Moved that a warrant be drawn for \$31.50,
and ask if any deduction or rebate could be made
on same,

Resignation of Adt. Knight as Councilman received

Ordinance in regard to fire insurance of City
for Municipal purposes be placed before Council
for action, upon being read for first time
was ordered posted,

In regard to alleged nuisance as regards
Krafft place, ordered that Marshall do
investigate, and according to law if
Necessary take proper means to control
same. Moved that Com on Streets & Pub
property be instructed if necessary to
put in walk running from Wang St to
Cor of 1st Street + B Streets across 1st Street South.
Moved Recorded and Corrid that all blasting
and other noxious matters within the City limits
be declared a nuisance - Subject to control of Council

In regard to obstructions to side walks, passed
that Sidewalks could not be obstructed by
any person, business or otherwise except
^{14 inches} ~~2 feet~~ on inside of said side walks, said
2 feet to be above level of side walk at least 18
