

Regular session of Council July 3, 1911.
The City Council of Canby met on the 3rd day of July 1911, and was called to order by the Mayor, Dr. H. A. Dedman at 8:00 o'clock P.M.

ed to present the matter of establishing
the grade of Second Street in front of
the M. E. Church in order that the church
authorities might put in a cement side-
walk. It was ordered that the Com. on
Streets and Public Improvement see that
this is done.
