

Regular Session of Council Aug 1st 1910

Council called to order by H.A. Dedman Mayor, on roll call the following were found present; Mayor H.A. Dedman Recorder Chas N. Wait, Chief of Police L.V. Dick, and Commissioners, H.N. Bair H.B. Simmons, J.J. Graham, H.W. Evans, H.H. Knight, Ross Mack and George Weeks.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved. An Ordinance Numbered 95 was introduced past first reading and was ordered posted. Said Ordinance was to correct Ordinance No 94 in regard to South Eastern extension of "C" Street from its present terminus on the South. Mr. Simmons talked in regard to the necessity of opening Fulton Street in accordance with the Ordinance heretofore passed. Referred to Committee on Streets & Pub Property.

The resignation of Warren Kendall as Street Commissioner was presented to Council and upon motion duly seconded it was accepted by the Council. Whereupon Jas. Lisset was unanimously elected as Supt of Streets.

Councilman Bair suggested that poor side walks be looked after at once. Referred to Committee on Streets & Pub Property to instruct Street Commissioner in regard to same. Upon motion Council Adjourned
