

Regular Session of Council Oct 3rd 1910
 Council called to order at 8 P.M. by
 H. C. Gilman President of Council
 On Roll call following were found to be
 present, E. N. Wair, Recorder, J. S. Dick, Chf of Police,
 Bair, Bates, ^{Graham} Gilman, Evans, Knight and Weeks.
 Councilman, Minutes of previous meeting read
 and approved, placed on file.
 Report of Treasurer read and placed on file.
 Report of Committee on Streets & Public Property
 in regard to Change of Charter as to Opening
 Streets in Barbey accepted.

The Committee having in charge the drafting
 of Amendments to the City Charter of Barbey, filed
 their report and certain Amendments to the City
 Charter of the City of Barbey, said proposed
 Amendments were read to the Council, and
 motion duly made, and seconded, and
 carried was ordered filed by the City Recorder.
 Whereupon on motion of Councilman Bair,
 duly made seconded and carried the
 following Resolution was adopted;

Resolution
 Be it resolved a bill for an act entitled as
 follows; To amend an act entitled "Charter
 of the City of Barbey" adopted by the people of
 Barbey at the general City Election, held on the
 1st day of December, 1907, be submitted to the
 legal voters of Barbey, Oregon, at the general
 City election to be held in said Barbey on the
 5th day of December, A.D. 1910, for their adoption
 or rejection.

Upon a vote being taken there voting aye
 were ~~For~~ Bair, Graham, Gilman, Evans, Knight
 and Weeks, Each one having voted Aye the Mayor
 declared Resolution carried and the Recorder
 was instructed to at once post the necessary
 notices as required by law.

Remarks made by Bair, Weeks and others in regard to side walks, on First Street - Moved and Carried that all property owners interested in the grading of First Street be interviewed in regard to grading and putting in side walks between D and E Streets -

Moved and Carried that City establish grade on 2nd Street,

Report of Chief of Police that City Jail be repaired in regard to certain matters, report accepted and jail ordered repaired. Commissioner Graham asked that a Street light be established at Corner of First and F Streets.

after discussion so ordered, and Committee on Streets & Pub Property instructed to see to it.

Mr Bair spoke in regard to improvement of "A" Street South to the City limits on South line of City Limits.

Moved and Carried that Committee on Streets and Public Property expend all money available in Road fund in 1910.

Resignation of Jas Lieser as Supt of Streets having been received and accepted, the Council proceeded to the election of Streets; Whereupon

O.R. Mack was unanimously elected as Supt of Streets.

It was then moved that the seat of Commissioner Chas T Bates be declared vacant by reason of the absence of Commissioner Bates for longer than the Charter allows, Carried -

Whereupon Jas Lieser was duly elected as Commissioner for unexpired term of Chas T. Bates.

M. I. Lee announced that he had carriage water and would at this date at "F and G" Streets - Council then adjourned to meet in regular Session Nov 4th 1910
