

The City Council met in regular Session Feb 6th 1910, and was called to Order by H. A. Dedman Mayor.

Present The Mayor, H. A. Dedman - Recorder Chas N Nait. Chief of Police J. S. Dick and Councilmen - Bair, Bates, Gilmore, Graham, Evans, Knight, Mack and Weeks.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved, after which the following proceedings were had

Committee on Streets & Public property instructed to confer with RR Co in regard to fencing North side of Gravel Pit. Petition of M. P. Saylor in regard to keeping Pool Rooms open on Sunday, on motion said petition was indefinitely postponed. Financial Reports of Treasurer and Recorder were read, accepted and filed. Bills against the City to the amount of \$79.37 presented, ordered paid. In regard to Fire Hydrants, Com on Fire & Water reported that they had investigated same and that there was present a representative of one firm furnishing such supplies the firm of A. F. Long & Co represented by Mr Plympton whereupon Mr Plympton made a proposition to the Council that his firm could and would furnish hydrants at \$27.00 and exhibit working of same he also exhibited form of Hydrant & back.

Geo Weeks was placed on Committee of Streets and Public property by Mayor to take place of Chas N Nait, resigned.

In regard to side walk on Grove Road Com on Streets & Pub property to report within 10 days. Question in regard to opening Street 300 feet East of ^{road of} Street leaving Mottalee Road. Referred to Com on Streets & Pub Property. Mr Bates asked that attention be paid to sidewalk sitting on Ashman property, after discussion Street Commissioner Wendall instructed to make any necessary repairs same. Council then adjourned to meet in Special Session at call of Mayor.
