

City Council met in adjourned session at Call of Mayor on Feby 15th 10- at 8 P.M.

Upon Roll call the following Members present.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved. Report of Com on Streets & Pub property read. Recommended that road be established on Fautou Street.

Mr A. H. Lee demands \$100.00, damages for real property to be used for extension of Lee Street to Fautou Street.

Council on Streets & Public property recommend that Street fenced in by Mr Geo Wesseling East of Road from Canby to Molalla, be opened.

Mr Gilmore in regard to Fautou Road Moved that what is known as Fautou Street be opened to 40 feet, the motion was duly seconded and Carried -

Moved and seconded that Street running East from Molalla Road be extended to intersect with so called Fautou Street, to be 40 feet wide, Carried -

Moved that Council ~~the~~ proceed to the election of City Surveyor, Seconded & Carried. Fred Roth was Nominated, Moved that rules be suspended and that City Recorder cast vote of Council for Fred Roth, as City Surveyor. The Mayor thereupon declared Fred Roth duly elected City Surveyor for ensuing term. Remarks were then made by Councilman A. H. Knight in regard to establishing grades for Cement walks, also by Evans as to a 2 1/2 foot Walk Concrete, on 2nd Street. Moved and Carried that Com on Streets & Pub prop have grade established on 2nd Street at time of Survey on Fautou Street. Adjourned

Minutes of last meeting read and approved
with the correction to be made that the report of
Committee on Streets & Pub property be filed —

Moved and Carried that Ordinance be drawn
extending 6 Street to Maple Street.

Moved that Carty Band be have right to run an
overhead flume on F Street 3 feet wide, to meet approval
of Street Committee upon a tie vote of 4 to 4, the
Mayor voted no. defeating the motion.

Carried & Moved that all Ordinances ordered passed
be done at earliest date possible,
and that Mayor can at any time call a meeting
to pass on same and Flume proposition,
as made by M. J. See —

After some talk by Gilman and
Knight in regard to Telephone wires, ordered
that Aurora Electric & Telephone Co be
instructed to place their wires not less than
20 feet of ground.

Thereupon W. H. Lucke was appointed a Deputy
Chief of Police, and was confirmed by Council.
Moved, Carried and Ordered that the Carty Band,
have the free use of the City Hall for, Dances,
Entertainments, Dances &c.

Thereupon Council adjourned to meet
at Call of Mayor.
