

Regular Session April 4th 1910

Council Called to order at 8 P.M. by H.O. Gilman President of Council. The Mayor thereafter appeared and took his seat.

Minutes of previous Council read and approved. Report of Treasurer read, approved and placed on file.

There was then received a verbal report from Committee on Streets that property that County Canal Co. be allowed to put Flume on E. Street, but put Siphon under 3rd Street so as not to obstruct Street for traffic.

It was then moved and carried that said County Canal Co. be granted a permit to build said flume as per report of Committee. Said flume to be completed within Six (6) Months of this date. The permit to use said flume be for 3 years be granted, said flume to be built on West side of E Street, under Supervision of Committee on Streets & Pub Prop. Ordered that Warrants be drawn to pay bills presented to the amount of \$65.³⁵

Ordered that Roads Leading North and Road leading East on South side of R.R. Track to Oregon City be proposed for grading and that Supervisor of Dist. be asked to do grading when same is proposed, and that City will stand east of same within City limits.

Recorder to notify Supervisor of action taken by Council.

After some talk by Councilmen on various matters, no action taken Council Adjourned.
