Regular Session Sept. 6th 1909.

The City Council met in regular session on the 6th day of Sept. 1909, at 8 o'clock P.M. At roll call, the following members of the Council were present, to wit: Recorder Wm. Knight & Chief Police C. Baty and Councilmen W.H. Bair, Chas. J. Bates, S.S. Fisher, C.N. Wait and Wilson Evans, - The absent were J.F. Mills, Mayor, H.C. Gillman, President of the Council, and J.A. Graham and F.H. Hilton.

The Mayor, and President of the Council, being absent; It was moved by Councilman Wait, and seconded by Bates, that Councilman W.H. Bair take the chair, and act as Mayor-Protem, and preside over the meeting, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

Minutes of last meeting read & approved, after which the following claims were read, audited and ordered paid by unanimous vote of the Councilmen present.

Claim of Claude Baty for Salary as Chief Police Aug. 15. 00

and that warrants be drawn accordingly.
In the matter of procuring a tank on wheels, the Committee on Fire and water, reported that no ready made Cart and tank could be found on the Market suitable for that purpose, but that they find that something suitable could be made for about \$30. The Committee was authorized to procure something suitable.

Leg session Sept 6th 1909 continued

The Committee on Streets & Public property was instructed to look after the pump on First Street, at the Post office, and have the same repaired.

Permission to remove the electric light from S.W. corner of Block 14, to N.E. corner of Block 10, on 3rd & C Street, was granted, under the direction of Committee of St. & P.P.

The Committee on Health & Police was instructed to look after some reported nuisance on Second Street, on lot 4 & 5 B. No. 3, &c. The Committee on Streets & Public property was instructed to have a dog-pound built on the City jail-lot, = and also ordered that the dog-license Ordinance be enforced.

In the matter of a proposed Ordinance regulating the speed of Automobiles, and other vehicles, and preventing trains, & cars standing on street & road crossings longer than 10 minutes &c., was introduced and read first time and ordered to be posted in 3 public places in the City, and to come up for final passage at the next reg. meeting in Oct, 1909.

In the matter of the resignation of Claude Baty, as Chief of Police of the City of Camby, filed with the recorder, and was read to the Council, was laid over to next reg. meeting for consideration.

The Council then adjourned in due form,
