

Special Annual Meeting Nov. 22^d 1909.

The City Council met in Special Session on the 22^d day of Nov. 1909, at 8 O'clock P.M. This meeting was called by the Mayor for the purpose of legalizing the tax levy by Ordinance, instead of making a levy without an ordinance as per last meeting of the Council.

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor at 8 O'clock P.M. Present the Mayor, Recorder & Chief and Councilmen W.H. Bair, Chas J. Bates, S.J. Fisher, H.C. Gellerson and J.A. Graham, Absent, Hilton Wait and Evans +

The reading of Minutes of last Meeting was dispensed with, and the Council proceeded to the reading of Ordinance; The proposed Ordinance for a five Mill tax levy was then brought up and read first time, after which, the Ordinance was, by Motion duly seconded and carried, Ordered to be posted, and to come up for final passage at the next regular meeting of the Council in December, which will be held on Wednesday the 8th day of Dec. 1909, to which date the Council adjourned in due form, on account of the annual City Election being held on the first Monday in December.
