

The City Council Met in Special Session on the 16th day of Feb'y 1909. This Special Session convened at the Call of a Majority of the members of the Council, at the Request of the Street Superintendent, for the purpose of bringing the matter up to the Council, in reference to draining the Streets of Candy, on first street, and especially in front of Block No. 1. between A. and B. Streets. The Council was called to Order at 5:00 o'clock P.M. by the Mayor J. F. Mitts.

There were present: The Mayor, Recorder and Councilmen W. H. Bair, Chas. J. Bates, J. A. Graham, H. C. Gilmore and H. W. Evans; absent: Fisher, Hilton and Wait.

The reading of Minutes of last reg meeting was dispensed with.

And the matter of draining said first street was taken up for consideration, and after due deliberation, a Motion was made by "Graham", seconded by "Bair", that the Street Superintendent be instructed to drain the Street in front of Block No. 1. which Motion, was amended; so as to leave the matter of draining and ditching, under the Supervision of the Committee on Streets and Public Property, together with the Street Superintendent, to go ahead and have it done. The "Motion" as amended, was put by the Mayor, and was Carried, unanimously, and was so Ordered, and the Council adjourned in due form.
