

The City Council met in reg session on the 3^d day of May 1909. and was called to Order by the Mayor J. F. Mitts at 8 O'clock P.M.

Present: the Mayor Recorder & Chief of Police and Councilmen Bates, Fisher, Gilmore, Graham wait and Evans, absent: Bair & Hilton

Minutes of last reg. meeting read, & stood approved. The following Claims against the City were then presented and Audited. to wit:

Total amt of warrants ordered drawn = \$65.60 by unanimous vote of the Council:

a Claim of 50^{cts} of Canby Tribune for publishing a Curfew Notice not after which the lease, of lower part of City Hall, to J. J. Sandness for a term of 5 Years, at \$20. per month, having been signed in duplicate, by the respective parties; was read by the Recorder. and duly accepted by the Council, and ordered placed on file, and approved by the Mayor. In the matter of collecting rent on lower story of City Hall, the finance committee reported that Ex Treasurer F. Gallner was expected to be present at this Meeting, but not being present, was laid over to next meeting. at this time, Councilman W. H. Bair appeared & took his seat after which; the Chairman of the fire and water Committee Chas. N. Wait; introduced Mr. L. J. Tolls, agent of, and representing A. G. Long, for the American Latrobe Fire Engine Co., who then addressed the Council in reference to Fire Apparatus, showing Specifications, and making proposals for furnishing a Chemical Fire Engine to the City of Canby, and after due consideration, by the City Council and Mayor, it was by motion duly seconded and Carried that the City of Canby Enter into Contract with said Company

after which; Proposals = Specifications and Contracts were written out in duplicate, for furnishing, and purchasing, of One to. 11. Two wheeled "Champion Chemical Fire Engine, The purchase price being Seven hundred and Fifty dollars, Terms of payment to be: Two Hundred dollars in Cash within 15. days after delivery &c. \$550.⁰⁰ in City warrants payable on or before two years from date of acceptance &c with interest at 6. per. cent. from date of delivery &c.

And after the reading of said Proposals = Specifications; and Contract, by the Recorder. It was by motion, duly seconded and Carried by unanimous vote of the Council, that said Proposals, Specifications and contract be accepted; and that the Mayor and Recorder be and hereby are authorized to sign said Contract on the part of the City of Canby, Oreg. Mr. L. J. Tolls having signed for the Company, and after the signing by the Mayor & Recorder the contract was placed on file by the Recorder &c.

After which: in the Matter of Sidewalks to be constructed. the Committee on Streets and Public property were instructed to take charge of such work in connection with the Superintendent of Streets; and that the Committee on Health & Police were to look after Wells &c in the City of Canby.

After which the Proposed Ordinance to prevent Cattle to run at large: was taken up and read first time; and by Motion. Seconded and Carried was Ordered posted as read &c after which it was Moved and Seconded to reconsider the motion, in reference to the matter of Cattle feeding & grazing on Certain Streets: Carried, and after amending the Matter; it was again Moved and Seconded that the Ordinance be posted as amended, and to come up for final action on reg. meeting on June 7th 1909. Carried by unanimous vote &c and was so Ordered,

In the matter of turning off of Street lights
Ordered that all lights be turned off
except on first street:

Ordered; that the Canby Band be allowed
space on the back part of the stage in the
City Hall. to construct a closet for the purpose
of storing injured instruments +

In the Matter of an application from
H.C. Gillmore and J.A. Graham, in behalf
of the Artisans Lodge; for the privilege
of using the City Hall on all Saturday
Evenings, for Lodge Meetings, for which use
they offered to pay at the rate of \$40.00 per year.

It was moved and seconded, to allow the
Hall to the Artisans, and that the City
enter into Contract; Carried +
