

Reg Session April 6<sup>th</sup> 1908.

The City Council met in regular session on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of April 1908. and was called to order at 8 O'clock P.M. by the Mayor. Roll call found all officers. <sup>and</sup> Members of the Council present, including the newly elected Councilman E. J. Sias, having previously been duly qualified by taking, and filing his Oath of Office with the Recorder.

Minutes of last reg. Meeting were read & stood approved.

X In the Matter of Establishing a Street, and Sidewalk across the R.R. Track, connecting E. St. with Weed Street of Weeds Addition to Canby. The Recorder reported that communication was had with the Superintendent L. R. Fields of the S.P. Co. stating that there is no objection to the changing of said Crossing in question, and that the S.P. Roadmaster had been instructed to have the crossing rails taken up and moved to point where the change is to be made. &c. It was to be understood, however, that the S.P. Co. was to do no work except between the rails.

The City Council, (by motion duly seconded and carried) accepted the proposition, and that the Street Superintendent be instructed to grade said crossing, and construct a sidewalk on the North side thereof, not less than 4 ft. wide, the planks to be laid crossways on stringers. X after which, the City report of the City Treasurer, was laid over until the next reg. Meeting in May.

X After which the following Claims against the City were read, audited, and ordered to be paid, by unanimous vote of the Council, and that orders be drawn for payment of same:

In the matter of Canby Tribune Bill, or Claim for reprinting 500. pages of City Charter amt. - \$5.00

Moved and Seconded that the bill be not allowed, which was lost by a standing vote of 5. to 3. after which, the motion and second to pay the bill, was with drawn, and the Finance Committee was instructed to investigate, & was so Ordered.

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After which, the Committee on Fire & Water, Reported (verbally) that the fire extinguishers were examined by them and put in order, the report was accepted. +

In the matter of fixing City jail, and arranging petitions, and placing Stone &c. It was Moved and Seconded, that the Committee on Streets and Public Property, be instructed to investigate, and to be allowed to act, and have full power to fix the jail as they may deem proper. the motion Carried and so Ordered +

After which the "Dog license Ordinance" was brot up, and read second time, and was placed on its final passage and passed the Council by a vote of Seven to One +

In the Matter of the proposed County Fair, contemplated to be located at, or near the City of Canby. It was Moved and Seconded, that the City of Canby, do subscribe to and purchase or buy Fifty (50.) Shares of Stock at Five dollars per Share, provided however, that this Subscription shall not be paid, until the said Fair-Society shall have sold three hundred Shares, or receive subscriptions to the amount of Fifteen hundred dollars worth of Stock, and provided further that said Fair shall be located within the Corporate limits of Canby, Clackamas County State of Oregon, the Motion was Carried by a unanimous vote of the Council, and so Ordered, +

After which, the application of O.R. Mack, for a franchise, or permission to lay water pipes along Maple & Water Streets of Woods addition to Canby, was granted. provided that said Streets be kept, or left in good condition as they now are,



x After which, an Application for Saloon License was presented and read, filed by C. S. Hinton, a vote was taken by the Council, which resulted in three votes for a license, and five votes against granting a License, and was so declared by the Mayor.

x After which the Application of Eugene Froesner was read, and vote taken, which resulted in two votes for and six votes against granting a License. & was so declared; and by motion, duly seconded & Carried, the Recorder and City Treasurer were duly authorized to return the receipts and money to the said applicant.

x The Application of Frank Antmann for a License was also read, but no action was taken by the Council for the reason that no receipt from the Treasurer, and no Bond had been filed with the Recorder as required;

x In the Matter of Street Lighting, It was moved seconded and Carried, that the Aurora Electric Co. shall light up Streets at half-rates, from this time on and up to the Month of August, according to Contract, and be paid for accordingly, and that the Chief Police be authorized to regulate the lights to that effect.

x In the Matter of a Sewer System suitable for a town like Canby, as Spoken of, by Messrs M. J. Lee and John Knight, before the City Council & such sewers to run under side walks, and being about 6 ft deep and 4 ft wide, &c; and while the Matter was about to be taken under Consideration,

a motion was made to adjourn which was duly seconded and Carried, and the Council adjourned,
