

The City Council met on the 4th day of May 1908. in Regular Session. and was called to Order by the Mayor J. F. Mitts at 8. O'clock P.M.

Present: The Mayor, Recorder & Chief of Police and Councilmen Bair, Riggs, Wait Fisher & Hilton; Absent Lucke, Weed and Lias.

Minutes of last Reg. Meeting was read; and after Amending the Same, in the matter of the proposed County Fair: to read: That the 50. Shares of Stock subscribed by the City of Canby, shall be paid whenever the Fair is located at Canby; and then stood approved;

After which the Treasurers Quarterly Report for the 1st Qtr. of 1908. was taken up, and the Recorder reported, that an error of 50. cents had been corrected, and that the report now corresponded with the books of the Recorder: and was so Accepted: After which the following Claims against the City were Audited and ordered paid:

In the matter of fixing, and reporting on jail, the Committee on Streets & P.P. asked for one Mo. time: Granted.

In the Matter of Log-Licence, and Checks, the Recorder was instructed to procure the same.

In the Matter of a proposed public road, in the northwesterly part of the City limits, represented by A. M. Vineyard and others: no definite action was taken by the City Council: leaving the Matter open for further deliberation, when properly brot before the Council by petition or otherwise. The Council then adjourned in due form - to meet on Wed. June 3rd 1908. in reg. session
