

Reg. Session June 3^d 1908

The City Council met in regular session on the 3^d day of June 1908, and was called to order at 8 O'clock P.M. by the Mayor J. F. Witte.
 Present: The Mayor, Recorder and Chief Police;
 and Councilmen Bair, Riggs, - Wait, -
 Fisher, - Hilton & Lucke; Absent: - Elias and Reed;
 Minutes of last meeting were read & stood approved.

The following Claims were then presented and read by the Recorder: to wit:

Ordered paid by unanimous vote of the Council to wit: 6 votes, & Orders to be drawn.

The Committee on Streets & P. P., reported, in the matter of jail repairs, that they were unable to procure competent workman, to do the work at the City jail, during the past month; further time granted.

The Chief of Police was instructed and permitted to have a general Cleanup in the City Hall, and including the soap-figures (1908) on the Hall windows; and to see to it, that the partition, which had not been fully removed from the flue in the Hall, should be examined, and if necessary, to remove the same, or otherwise making the same fireproof.

In the matter of making new, and repairing old sidewalks: It was by motion duly seconded and Carried: that the Superintendent of Streets notify property owners to repair, or make new sidewalks along their property, as the same may be required along first Street, and from the S. P. R. R. track, near cor. of 1st & A. Sts. to Wm Vorpahl's Residence, on easterly side of Public road, and from said Vorpahl's Residence, running East, on the south side of Public road, to the easterly boundary of the City limits; and it was further ordered, by motion duly 2^d & Carried, that the sidewalks from R. R. Tracks to said Vorpahl's

Residence. shall be New walks, and that portion running east along south side of Public Road, from Vorpahl's corner to the City limits, shall be repaired, and put in good order; provided however; that said new sidewalk to be constructed from R.R. Track to said Vorpahl's Residence shall be not less than four (4) feet in width, and provided further: that the foregoing Motion is duly seconded and Carried, shall be deemed an Order to construct, and repair sidewalks along the streets, and Public roads designated; and that notices, to build such sidewalks, shall be given in accordance to sections 63, & 64 of the City Charter of Canby.

In the Matter of working out their Road Poll tax: The Street Supt was authorized to allow such work to be done, at any place on the streets, or roads, wherever, in his judgment, it may be required; after which, by motion duly seconded & Carried the Council adjourned.

The City Council met in Reg Session on the 6th day of July 1908, and was called to order by the Mayor at 8.30 O'clock P.M.:

Present: the Mayor; Recorder and Chief of Police and Councilmen: Bair, Riggs, Wait: Elias and Hilton: Absent, Fisher, Lucke and Breed:

Minutes of last reg. Meeting read & stood approved; after which a Petition was presented; and read by the Recorder: which petition was signed by 48 Citizens of the City of Canby: directed to the Hon: Mayor & City Council: asking for the establishment of a street and crosswalk, across the R.R. Track south of the Depot, being an extension of "C" Street of Canby; and after due consideration, it was by Motion duly seconded and Carried, that the Petition be placed on file; and that the Recorder communicate with the R.R. Officials in reference to the matter, in order that the establishment of said crossing could be proceeded with according to the prayer of the petitioners, & to the satisfaction of the R.R. Company;
