Kocher, leasing the lower room of the City Hall to A. Kocher for another year, and accepting the same as executed: The Council adjourned in due form, to meet in Special Session, if deemed necessary, during month of Sept., and at the call of the Mayor.

Reg. Meeting Oct 5th 1908.

The City Council met in regular session on the 5th day of October 1908. and was called to order by the Mayor at 8. O'clock P.M.

Present - The Mayor, Recorder & Chief and Councilmen Bair, Wait, Sias Fisher & Roth: Absent. Hilton and Locke. &

Minutes of last meeting read, & stood approved. After which, a communication, or letter from Mr. Max Telford was read by the recorder, in reference to right of way for a street across said Telfords land, extending "C" Street from depot grounds to Maple Street, - Stating that he deemed the offer of One hundred dollars for the right of way, ridiculous, and that his price was, One thousand dollars for said right of way &c: Whereupon after due consideration, it was moved & seconded that the Committee on Streets & Public property, be instructed to get a written statement from H. A. Sadman, agreeing to exchange an equal amount of land with Mr. Max Telford, for the amount of land required for the right of way through Mr Telfords land for said proposed Street, and that the Committee make a proposition

to Mr. Max Telford for such an exchange of land as aforesaid, and provided, that if the exchange of lands be perfected by and between Dr. H. A. Bedman and Max Telford.

Then, ~~Dr. H. A. Bedman~~ would agree to give the whole right of way for said proposed street from Depot grounds to Maple Street for and in consideration of Three hundred dollars.

The Motion carried by unanimous vote, & so Ordered; After which, the Policy, Reinsuring City Hall in the Oregon Fire Relief Association, was read, and after due consideration, it was moved & seconded that, ^{whereas} the wording: (occupied ~~only~~ as a city Hall) does not include the lower story, occupied as an implement and Hardware store, as properly insured; it be ordered that the Recorder return the Policy to be worded so as to include the lower story; and that after the correction has been made, the claim of said Fire Relief Association amounting to \$24.90 shall be remitted by the Recorder, which amount is hereby ordered paid, and that an Order be drawn for the same. The motion carried by unanimous vote, and was so Ordered. In the matter of the City report, the City Treasurer was allowed time to report at next reg. Meeting. After which the following claims against the City were presented, read and Audited, and Ordered paid by unanimous vote of the Council, and that Orders be drawn in favor of Claimants accordingly, to wit:

In the matter of a verbal request, by A. A. Hilton, Corbit and Fellows & others for a road to be established from said party part of City limits, to City of Conlay; No action was taken in the matter;

In the Matter of an Ordinance; presented by Mr. Lee, to the City Council for a franchise; To grant to said Mr. Lee, his heirs and assigns, the right and privilege to install, maintain and operate a water system in the Town of Canby Oregon, was read by the Recorder, and after taking the matter under consideration, it was Moved and Seconded, that this matter be referred to a Committee of the whole Council, to prepare the Ordinance, and report at a Special Meeting of the Council, to be held on Monday the 12th day of Oct, 1908, at the usual hour in the Evening; The Motion was Carried, and so Ordered; after which; an Ordinance was introduced by Mr. J. Lee, and read by the Recorder, asking for a franchise, Granting to said Mr. J. Lee his heirs and Assigns, the right and privilege to construct, maintain, and operate an Electric light and power plant and system, &c. in the town of Canby Oregon, which Ordinance, was by motion duly Seconded and Carried, also; referred to a Committee of the whole, and to be reported at the Special Meeting, to be held on Monday the 12th day of Oct, 1908, After which the Recorder was instructed to draw up an Ordinance, Licensing Shows, Billiard tables, ball racks, and all kinds of Amusements &c; to be presented to the Council at the next reg. Meeting; Also; Ordered that the Committee on Streets and Public Property, be instructed to collect the road fund due the City of Canby, from the County of Clackamas; Also, Ordered; that Band Boys, are not required to pay Hall rent for the social dance on Saturday night last; After which; by motion duly Seconded and Carried Business on the table was taken ^{up}, Consisting of the Cost Bill in Recorder's Court, of amt. \$22.25 Canby vs. H.K. Jackson; Moved and Seconded that the Bill be paid; a ballot being taken; resulted in Councilmen Fisher & Bair Voted Yes, & Wait, Sias & Roth Voted No; and was declared Lost; Council then Adjourned in due form, to meet in Spcl Sessn. Monday Oct. 12th 1908, to consider 2 Franchise Ordinances, & such other Business properly brought up, Wm. Knight, Recorder
