

Special Session Oct. 14th 1907.

The City Council met in Special Session on the 14th day of Oct 1907, and was called to order by the Mayor, L. D. Walker at 8 O'clock P. M. Roll call found all present. Except Chief J. L. Dick and Councilmen Roth and Stogsdill, Minutes of last meeting, read & stood approved, After which, the Proposed New City Charter was taken under consideration by the Council for the adoption of the same, and ordering the same, to be placed before the people at the next City Election in Dec, and, after due consideration, by reading, and passing upon the Charter, section by section, of all new, and changed matter contained in the New Charter, as prepared by the committee heretofore appointed for that purpose, and as the same now reads; It was, by motion duly seconded and Carried by unanimous vote, that the Proposed City Charter be accepted, and adopted as a whole, [Except; that Sec. 75, be stricken out, and, Substitute Sec. 105, of the present Charter, instead], (to be numbered Sec. 75.) Also; Moved seconded and Carried that the proposed Charter be submitted to the people for ratification at the next Annual City Election in Dec, 1907; and that the recorder be, and is hereby instructed to prepare all matter necessary to bring the Charter before the people, at said next City Election.

In the matter of Draining and ditching along Block 10, 1 and Easterly thereof, which was referred to Committee on St. & P. R. at the last meeting, reported, verbally that no work had been done yet, but contemplated to dig a large pit, or Cesspool at cor. of first & A. Streets &c, = no definite action was taken on said report by the Council, except that it was deemed best, not to make the same too expensive; but by motion duly seconded and Carried, the Committee was authorized to continue until the work was completed; Council then adjourned in due form
