

The City Council met in Special Session on the 25th day of Nov, 1907, and was called to order by the Mayor "L.D. Walker" at 8 O'clock P.M. Present the Mayor, Recorder & Chief of Police and Councilmen, Bair, Hampton, Roth, Stogdell & Wait. absent - Graham Riggs and Zeek.

This meeting having been called by the Mayor for the purpose of filling vacancies on the Election Board: as follows to wit Ralph Knight and Wilson Evans having been nominated on the Citizens ticket for Councilmen, and A.H. Knight for Mayor on said ticket. Therefore the offices of 2 Judges and one Clerk have been deemed vacant on said Election Board whereupon C.J. Roth, and Henry Smith were placed in nomination for Judges, of Election and W^m Cantwell for Clerk, and by motion duly seconded and Carried. The Nominees were declared the duly appointed Judges and Clerk respectively to fill said vacancies &

after which, the Matter of Referring the proposed City Charter to the people, at the City Election on Dec. 2^d 1907, And the City Recorder having been previously authorized to make all necessary preparation for such Election proposed to place the matter of "Bond Issue" (as designated in Sec's 71, 72 & 73, of the proposed City Charter) before the people as a Separate Measure, and to be voted upon accordingly, which proposition was by motion, duly seconded, & Carried, Sustained, and so Ordered, after which the Council adjourned in due form &
