

The City Council met in reg. Session on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of March 1907. and was called to order by the Mayor at 7:30 O'clock P.M.

Present the Mayor B.L. Mack, Recorder Wm Knight and Chief of Police James Evans, and Councilmen J.A. Graham, F. Hampton, A.W. Riggs, Chas J Roth, W.H. Bair, C.T. Wait, and John Zeck. Absent "J.S. Dick",

Minutes of last meeting (Feb. 4<sup>th</sup>-07) was read and stood approved. Excepting that the order allowing Gro. Kesselring to fence up certain streets, was by motion duly seconded and carried, "rescinded".

After which: An Ordinance: forbidding the holding, storing or keeping of Powder or other explosives, in corporate limits & Canby, &c.

was read first time, and ordered posted to come up for final passage March 19<sup>th</sup> 1907, at a Special meeting to be held on that date.

In the matter of City Treasurers Bond. Ordered that the same be accepted as soon as perfected.

In the matter of the Resignation of J. Evans as Chief of Police, which was filed with the Recorder was accepted by the Council, by motion duly seconded and carried.

In the matter of the proposition submitted by the Anna Electric Co. for furnishing Electric Current for street lighting, it was moved Sec<sup>d</sup> and carried, that the 25 dollar a month proposition, would be favorably considered, provided the City would not be obliged to take more than six months in one year.

After which J.S. Dick was duly elected Chief of Police, to fill vacancy. Also moved Sec. & Carried to pay \$15.00 per mo. to Chief of Police and that an Ordinance be drawn to come up March 19<sup>th</sup> 1907 for final reading. Council then adjourned to meet March 19-07 in special session.
