

Reg. Session April 1st 07

The City Council met in Reg. Session on the First day of April 1907 and Called to Order at 8 O'clock P.M. by the Mayor. Full council Present + Minutes of last meeting read + stored approved, After which, three (3) Applications for Saloon License were considered + and after the Council being satisfied that notices had been duly posted as required, and the receipts of the Treasurer filed with the Recorder, and Bonds duly Executed and filed with the Recorder, except that the Bonds of Ben Burmacer had not been Completed, by the failure of the Bondsmen to be qualified: and the Bond of Frank Astmann had not been returned from Portland and not been filed with the Recorder, but the Bond of H.K. Jackson having been duly filed with the Recorder, it was moved that license be granted to H.K. Jackson, but before any further proceedings were had, It was Moved and Seconded, to amend the Motion: That all the Licenses be granted, upon the completion, and filing, of the Bonds of Astmann and Burmacer, within a week; which amendment was duly Carried. The Motion was then put, as amended, and was duly Carried, and so declared by the Mayor,

After which the following Claims were, Audited and Ordered paid by unanimous vote of the Council; To wit:

After which, "An Ordinance providing for the width and manner of constructing Side walks" - was taken up from the table, and read 2^d time, and was amended - and Ordered posted as amended, to come up at next reg meeting in May, for final Action;

Report of Select Committee on Charter amendment, committee, by Chairman Beck reported that their business had not been completed, & was allowed more time. After which Treasurers 1st Atty report, was read, and accepted, showing amt on hand of \$1268.69 Mch 31st 1907.

The Proposed Ordinance regulating the Salary of Chief of Police; was taken up and read second time, and placed on its final passage, and passed by unanimous vote of the Council.

The Ordinance to Establish Monuments on 1st and "C" Streets; was then taken up and read 2^d time, and placed on its final passage, and passed the Council by a unanimous vote.

The Ordinance to Establish Grades on 1st & C Streets &c, was then read 2^d time, and placed on final passage and passed by unanimous vote of the Council.

After which a proposed Ordinance Authorizing the Sale of City Jail Lot, was read first time, and by motion duly seconded and Carried, was Ordered passed to come up for final action, May 6th 1907.

And after discussing the matter of the City furnishing Material to build Sidewalks, and Owners of adjoining lots to do the work in laying down Sidewalks &c,

The Council adjourned in due form.
