

Reg. meeting May 6th 1907.

The City Council met in reg. Session on the 6th day of May 1907. and was called to Order at 8 O'clock P.M. by the Mayor. All present, except J. Beck. Minutes of last reg meeting read & stood approved. In the matter of an Application, filed by C.S. Hinton for a License to Sell Spirituous & Malt liquors, the Council being satisfied that Notices had been posted, and the receipt of the City Treasurer for \$100.⁰⁰ had been filed with the recorder. Together with a bond duly executed, it was moved, 2^d and carried that a License be granted, and issued to said C.S. Hinton for the 2^d Qtr. 1907. Allowing a rebate for One month of \$33.³⁰ no. business having been transacted by said Hinton during the month of April in said 2^d Qtr.

In the matter of transferring liquor license of Frank Ackmann, to O.C. Churchill, for the unexpired time of the Second Quarter 1907, It was by motion duly seconded and Carried, that said Transfer of license be granted, (upon the filing of a proper Bond duly executed, by said O.C. Churchill with qualified bondsmen), in the office of City Recorder. After which, the following Claims against the City, were read, Audited and Ordered paid by unanimous vote of the Council, to wit:

After which the Ordinance providing for the width and manner of constructing sidewalks, was read the 3^d time, and was amended so that all sidewalks should have a curb not less than 12 inches deep, and 3 inches in thickness, and was ordered to be posted again as amended, and to come up in reg. June meeting for final passage.

The Ordinance authorizing sale of jail lot, was read 2^d time, and passed the City Council by unanimous vote.

After which, the Recorder was Authorized to procure a Record-book, suitable for the Recording of all Ordinances,

after which, it was by motion duly 2^d & Carried, that the Supt. of Streets be instructed to repair "C" Street between 1st and 2^d, by grading, and gravelling, the same, according to the established grade of said Street, and to be properly ditched, under the Supervision of Committee on Streets & Pub. Prop.

In the matter of making a Cement Sidewalk in front of the City Hall, it was moved & seconded that the Recorder post Notices for bids to be received up to June 3^d 1907. for the construction of such Cement Sidewalks, as the walk in front of the Canby Bank &c. "Motion Carried"; reserving the right to reject any or all bids.

In the matter of repairing the grade of the hillside, at East end of the County bridge across the Molalla river, It was moved and seconded, that the City of Canby will pay One half of the expenses of repairing said road or grade, provided that the whole of such repairs shall not exceed Fifty dollars; Carried; and that the work be done under the Supervision of Road Supervisor of Dist. No. 17.

In the matter of constructing sidewalk, at, over or around the Well, at lots 1, & 2, in Block 3, on first Street, was referred to the Committee on Streets & Pub. Prop. to examine the matter, and report to the City Council at the next reg. meeting in June.

Hurst, Ingr. in reference to "Street lighting", was read, and after due consideration the Proposition of the said Co. was; by Motion, duly Seconded and Carried; Accepted; and that the Committee on Fire and Water be Authorized to select places for lights to be placed, and No. of lights to be used, and to Contract for same,
