In the matter of making a Cement sidewalk
in front of the City Hall, it was moved & seconded
that the Recorder post Notices for bids to be received
up to June 3^d 1907, for the construction of such Cement
sidewalks, as the walk in front of the County Bank.
"Motion Carried;" reserving the right to reject any or all bids.

In the matter of repairing the grade of the hillside,
at East end of the County bridge across the Molalla river.
It was Moved and Seconded, that the City of Canby
will pay One half of the expenses of repairing said road or grade
provided that the whole of such repairs shall not
exceed Fifty dollars; Carried; and that the work be
done under the supervision of Road Supervisor of St. to 17.

In the matter of constructing sidewalk, at, over or
around the well, at lots 1, 2, 3 in Block 3, on First Street.
Was referred to the Committee on Streets & Pub. Prop.,
to examine the matter, and report to the City Council
at the next reg. meeting in June.

Excepting to those who are liable to pay a road-poll-tax, and that orders be drawn on the City Treasurer, after making said reduction of Road Poll tax & ~~off - 5.00~~ & so ordered by unanimous vote, ~~(amt of warrant issued \$ 113.02)~~

After which, the street super. was authorized and instructed to remove the water trough from the well on first street, by a motion duly seconded and carried,

Chairman Zeek of the Charter Committee, stated, that the committee was not prepared to make any report, and asked for further time to report. "Granted" after which, the Ordinance, "providing for the width and manner of constructing sidewalks," was taken up, ^{read 4th time} and placed on its final passage, and passed the Council by unanimous vote of all councilmen present (being 5 votes.)

In the matter of Oiling the Streets, it was moved and seconded, that the Committee on St. & Pub. Property be authorized to have first street oiled along 3 or 4 blocks, provided, the committee

does not deem it too expensive, after ascertaining and estimating the cost thereof, "Carried,"

After which, bids for the construction of Cement sidewalks were opened and read. One bid from "B. F. Salmon", of Salem Oregon was for Sixty dollars, (\$60.⁰⁰); or, at the rate of One dollar and Twenty cents (\$1.²⁰) per running foot, and One bid from "Wilson Evans" of Banks, Or. was for One dollar and Thirty five cents (\$1.^{.35}) per foot running measure.

After which it was Moved and seconded, that the Bid of B. F. Salmon be accepted, the motion "Carried", and so Ordered, the Council then adjourned in due form.
