Council met at 8 P.M., called to order by the Mayor V.L. Mack. Upon Roll Call there were present: V.L. Mack—Mayor, Chas N. Wait Recorder—Jas Evans Chief of Police, and Commissioners J.S. Dick, J.A. Graham, A. Koehler, Jas. Phayley, A.W. Riggs, Chas J. Roth + Mrs. Vorpahl.

There were bills to the amount of \$ 98.52 presented against the City as follows, to wit

After much discussion as to the ways, means, plans and system of the proposed Water Works, the Recorder was instructed to prepare and have ready on Wednesday evening Aug 8th for action at a special meeting of the Council on that date, an Ordinance for the Construction of Water Works, said Ordinance was duly prepared submitted and

After General Talk on various matters the Council adjourned to meet on Wednesday August 8th at 7.30 P.M.
