Regular Meeting of City Council,
October 8th 1906. Council met at 8 P.M.
Called to order by Mayor V.L. Mack, Upon

After which Ordinance granting franchise
and rights to Aurora Electric Co was brought
up and after discussion and amendments
was ordered posted to come up for final
passage November 5th 1906, The Amendments
on said proposed Ordinance cut down
the term of said Ordinance to 15 years, and
said Aurora Electric Company agreed to
furnish free light to the Amt of \$3.00 per month
to be used in the City Hall, and the City
to put in and install a light Meter,

Report of Committee on Road fund received
Mr George Knight of said Committee reported
that County Board had appropriated to Canby
50 per cent of Road Tax within Corporate
limits so soon as real property within
said Corporate limits was described so that
distribution could be made.

It was moved and carried that City Assessor
go to Oregon City, Investigate records and
proceed to segregate Canby property so said
apportionment could be made.

Moved that Recorder prepare an Ordinance
to build Cement Sidewalk on First
Street in front of City Hall Lot 4 Block 3.
