Report of City Assessor read and received.
Ordinance granting to Aurora Electric Co
a franchise after due posting came up
for final passage and was duly passed,
and approved by the Mayor—

An Ordinance granting to the North Western
Long Distance Telephone Co was introduced
and on motion ordered passed.

An Ordinance authorizing the City to
construct a cement side walk in
front of City Hall was then introduced
and on motion ordered passed both to
come up at special meeting of November
November 14th 1906,

Petition of Ben Birnmaser to erect and
maintain a Bowling Alley on his property
near corner of First and A. Streets laid on
Table to come up at next meeting.

Remarks were made on Charter Revision
by Messrs Dixon, Knight, Graham and others.
It was moved and carried that Mayor appoint
a Committee of three with full power to hire an
Attorney and revise Charter of Canby as regards
boundary lines and any other matters necessary,

Said Amended Charter to come before the duly qualified Citizens of Canby at the next Election for Ratification. The Mayor appointed on said Committee, A. Kocher, A. W. Riggs, and Chas N. Wait; Thereupon said Council Adjourned to meet Wednesday evening November 14th 1906 at 7.30 P.M.

Special Meeting of City Council November 14th 1906. Council met at 8 P.M. by Mayor V.L. Mack, at Roll Call there were present: V.L. Mack, Mayor Chas N. Wait, Recorder, Jas Evans Chief of Police and Councilmen, Dick, Graham, Kocher, Phegley, Riggs and Roth, Petition of B Bernauer to erect Bowling alley taken from table, Voted on and lost, A resolution was introduced and passed that a permit be granted to any property owner to build a cement side walk, after getting permit from Committee on Streets and Public property, said walk to be built in conformity with side walk to be built by City. After which Ordinance No 77, Granting a franchise to the Northwestern Long Distance Telephone Company went on final passage and was duly passed, After which Ordinance No 78, Authorizing the City to build a Cement Side walk went on final passage, and was duly passed, Thereupon Judges and Clerks of Election were appointed as follows; Judges C. J. Roth, J. S. Dick, A. W. Riggs, - Clerks: L. E. Hrazier, and Chas N. Wait. Thereupon it was moved to adjourn to meet the 1st Wednesday after 1st Monday in December
