

Special Meeting January 17th 1906.

Pursuant to a call of the Mayor the Council met in the City Hall of Canby on the evening of January 17th at 7.30 P.M. and was called to order by Mayor V.L. Mack. The roll of officers and members being called responded as follows. Present Mayor V.L. Mack, Chief of Police Jas Evans, Recorder Chas N Wait, - Councilmen, J.L. Dick, J.A. Graham, A Koeber, Jas Phegley, A H Riggs, Chas J Roth - Absent, Col Baird and Fred Hampton.

Minutes of last meeting read and stood approved as read.

After which proposed Ordinance No 72 "Entitled an Ordinance to prohibit mirrors from being on the streets after certain ^{hours} of and at night" went to its first reading, was passed and ordered posted.

Thereupon proposed Ordinance No 73, Entitled an Ordinance to prohibit Gambling and public Gaming in Canby went to its first reading, was passed and ordered ^{no 74} posted.

Thereupon Ordinance proposed, Entitled an Ordinance to purchase a bell for the use of the Town of Canby went to its first reading was passed and ordered posted.

After a discussion of the improvement of Front Street by carrying off the water therefrom, the Council upon motion adjourned to meet at next regular session Feb 5th 1906.
