

# Regular Meeting of Council Feby 5<sup>th</sup> 1906

The City Council of Canby met on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of February 1906, and was called to order at 7.30 O'clock P.M. by the Mayor V.L. Mack.

Roll call being made there were present V.L. Mack, Mayor, Jas Evans, Chief of Police, Chas H Wait, Recorder

Thereupon the matter of election of a Councilman to fill vacancy occurring by the death of Carl Bair was taken up, one ballot being taken, Mr Vorpahl having received a majority of all the votes he was declared duly elected, Mr Vorpahl being present took the oath of office and was sworn in as Councilman.

Thereupon Ordinances No 72-73 and 74 were put upon their final passage and were all of them passed by the Council—

Question as to drainage of Front Street brought up and after discussion Recorder was instructed to write to S.P. Ry Co to see if a right could be obtained from said Company to run a pipe or Culvert across and under the right of way of said S.P. Ry Co at the East end of Front Street, so as to drain said Front Street to the South,

Condition of 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, referred to Come on Streets & Pub Property,

It was agreed and determined that Council

would donate said floor to the  
Carmy School board for use in the  
Carmy School house,

Telephone Co Agreement read to Council  
Councilman Vorpahl placed on Committee  
to fill vacancy caused by death of Ed Bair,  
Council then adjourned to meet at
