Regular meeting of City Council

July 2nd 1906. Council met at 8 P.M. and called to order by the Mayor V. L. Mack; Roll call being made there were present; V. L. Mack Mayor, Chas N Wait Recorder, Jas Evans Chief of Police, and Councilmen, J. S. Dick, J. A. Graham, A Kocker James Phegley, Chas J. Roth and Mrs Vorpahl. There were bills to the amount of \$47.90 then presented against the City and ordered paid, to wit;

There was then a discussion from all present in regard to the prohibition of Cows running on the streets and roads within the City Limits, Recorder ordered to draw up an Ordinance in regard to same, Also discussion as to Minors getting on and of Moving Trains within City Limits, Mr Kocker introduced and spoke on the question of procuring City water and

erecting necessary works for same, after which the discussion by Councilmen then present was general, Mr Astman being present was allowed to give his views in regard to Water Works. It was then moved and carried that a Committee be appointed by the Mayor, to ascertain the terms that ground could be obtained from The S P Ry Co for, On that Committee Councilmen A. Koeber and A.W. Riggs were appointed, There was also considerable discussion as to cleaning up Streets, Ordered that Street Superintendent see that Streets be cleaned up and nuisances be abated, There being no further business to come before the Council at this date, moved and carried that Council be and is Adjourned until next regular meeting or until called to convene by the Mayor, Read and approved
July 14th 1906.

July 14th 1906. Special Meeting called by Mayor to hear report of Committee on Water Works; Present Mayor V.L. Mack, Recorder Chas N Wack, Chief of Police Jas Evans, and Councilmen; Dick, Graham, Koeber, Phegley, Roth and Vorpahl,

The Committee on Water Supply, Messrs. Koeber and Riggs reported their efforts in regard to getting S.P. Ry to furnish ground for necessary water station for Cambly Water Works, and received from said Company an application blank to be filled out, in regard to the report a general discussion took place, the report of Committee was received and ordered filed, A new City Water^{Works} Committee was then appointed, on motion duly passed, and A. Koeber and J.S. Dick were appointed as said Committee, and were duly authorized to go ahead, with full power to proceed and build and install a water works or system of same
